Subject: Allocation/Release of Central funds under Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY) during 2011-2012 – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject above and to say that on the basis of the total funds made available for the implementation of the Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY) for 2011-2012 and estimated incidence of urban poverty in the States/UT (based on Tendulkar Committee Report on Estimation of Poverty), **tentative allocation** under SJSRY for the States/UTs has been made by the Ministry. *Statement giving this tentative allocation is enclosed as Annexure - I.*

2. This Ministry has fixed an annual target of assisting 1,25,000 urban poor in setting up individual/group micro-enterprises for self-employment (75,000 under USEP and 50,000 under UWSP), and also providing skill training to 2,75,000 urban poor under STEP-UP component at the National level during the year 2011-2012. Also, a target of assisting 1,00,000 urban poor women (in groups) through revolving fund under SHG/T & CS has been prescribed. State/UT wise targets have been prescribed accordingly by distributing the all India targets in proportion to the incidence of urban poverty in the States/UTs. Further, in this year's budget separate sub-components for SCs and STs (Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe Sub-Plan) have been introduced providing separate allocation for SCs and STs. Targets for the Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) will be **30619 and 3264** respectively for setting up individual micro-enterprises under USEP, and **63001 and 6720** respectively for imparting skill training to urban poor under STEP-UP.

3. Under the Prime Minister's 15 Point Programme for Minorities, 15% of the Physical/Financial targets for USEP and STEP-UP components, are to be allocated for the Minority Communities. Accordingly, at the National level, targets for the Minority Communities will be **11250** for setting up individual micro-enterprises under USEP (15% of 75,000), and **41250** for imparting skill training to urban poor under STEP-UP (15% of 2,75,000). These National targets will be proportionately distributed in the States/UTs in proportion to the number of minority urban poor, as per the List made available by the Ministry of Minority Affairs. For the Financial Targets for the Minorities, the indicative allocation for the USEP and STEP-UP components, i.e. **Rs. 3717.17 Lakhs**, has been allocated between the States/UTs in proportion to the number of minority urban poor, *Statement giving this tentative allocation is enclosed as Annexure - I & Targets at Annexure -II.*

4. In addition to general practice of keeping 3% of SJSRY fund for IEC activities, Rs.5.00 Crore is allocated to States for undertaking specific city-wise capacity building programmes for focusing on the cities with more than one lakh population in States (more than 25000/50000 in small UTs and NER States). State-wise allocation is placed at **Annexure - III**. Funds will be released to States/UTs for undertaking city specific capacity building programmes at the rate of maximum of Rs. 1.00 Lakhs per programme.

5. The Central funds will be released to the States/UTs for the Scheme of SJSRY as a whole, and the State/UTs will be given flexibility to distribute the funds in the various components of SJSRY as per their requirement and also subject to meeting the physical targets as prescribed. However, in order to have balanced coverage of all components and better fund utilization, the available funds under SJSRY (Central + State share) may be allocated in following ratio:

A&OE = 5% & IEC = 3%

*Balance available fund (Central + State share) may be distributed as under:*

USEP	=	20%
UWSP	=	20%
STEP-UP	=	30%
UWEP	=	20%
UCDN	=	10%

6. Release of funds to the States/UTs will be made in two installments of **50% each**. First installment will be released to the States/UTs as soon as they become eligible under the prescribed criteria of receipt of UCs and matching State share release. *The balance 50% of the allocation will be released after reviewing the physical progress made by the States/UTs during the year against the targets as well as release of the matching State share for the portion already released during the current year.*


7. The prescribed criteria for the release of funds in 2011-2012 will be:

- (i). 100% receipt of UCs for the Central funds released upto the year 2009-2010; and
- (ii). 100% release of the cumulative matching State share for the Central funds released upto 2010-2011.

8. You are therefore requested to utilize the unspent funds available with your State/UT under SJSRY, at the earliest and submit the Utilization Certificates to this Ministry. The shortfall of the matching State share should also be immediately released so that the first instalment of this year's tentative allocation to your State/UT can be released at the earliest.


