
Subject: National targets for the scheme amenable to earmarking under Prime Minister's New 15-Point Programme for the welfare of Minority for the year 2011-12.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Minority Affairs's O.M. No. 3(3)/2011-PP-II dated 27th June, 2011 on the subject cited above and to say that under the Prime Minister's 15-Point Programme for Minorities, 15% of the Physical/Financial targets for Urban Self Employment Programme (USEP) and Skill Training for Employment Promotion amongst Urban Poor (STEP-UP) component, are to be allocated for the Minority Community. Accordingly, at the National level, targets for the Minority Communities will be 11250 for setting up individual micro-enterprises under USEP (15% of 75000), and 41250 for imparting skill training to urban poor under STEP-UP (15% of 275000). These National targets will be proportionately distributed in the States/UTs in proportion to the number of minority urban poor, as per the List made available by the Ministry of Minority Affairs.

2. As per the approved formula of allocation between the various components of SJSRY, 8% is earmarked for city-wide Information Education Communication (IEC) and Administrative & Other Expenses (A&OE). Thus, 92% is available for the 5 component of SJSRY: USEP, STEP-UP, UWSP, UWEP and UCDN. 50% of the 92% available is earmarked for USEP and STEP-UP and thus the effective percentage of budget for minorities under SJSRY comes to 6.90% of the total budget under SJSRY (15% of 46%). The other components of the scheme are not amenable to reservation on account of them being general in nature. The basis for this figure is already explained to Ministry of Minority Affairs vide reference enclosed (**Annexure-II**).

3. The indicative allocation for the USEP and STEP-UP components i.e. Rs.3717.17 Lakhs, has been allocated between the States/UTs in proportion to the number of minority urban poor, Statement giving this tentative allocation is enclosed (**Annexure-I**).
